

Donate Sample Medications to Patients in Need

The Dispensary of Hope is a national not-for-profit organization that recovers surplus medications from manufacturers, distributors, and physician and redistributes them to the uninsured. Through their “Fill the Box Fill the Need” campaign, physicians across the country are donating their short-dated and surplus sample medications to the Dispensary of Hope, who then makes them available for charitable clinics and pharmacies to order.

The donation process is free and simple. Receive a Hope Box at your practice, fill it with medications that have reached six months prior to expiration, seal it, and apply the prepaid shipping label. After the Dispensary of Hope receives your donation, you’ll receive a faxed, itemized, receipt for your records, along with a new Hope Box to fill the following month.

The program is mutually beneficial for practices and patients. By proactively donating sample medications to the program, physicians are PREVENTING medication waste, increasing sample management compliance, saving time and destruction costs, and ultimately providing desperately needed medications to patients that would otherwise go without. The goal: Never let a single pill go to waste (i.e. expire) before reaching a patient—especially while millions of patients go without the medications they desperately need. 100% HOPE Zero WASTE
